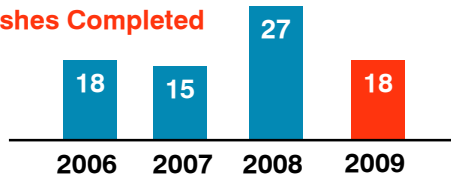




2009 Financial Report

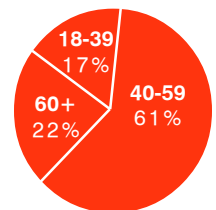

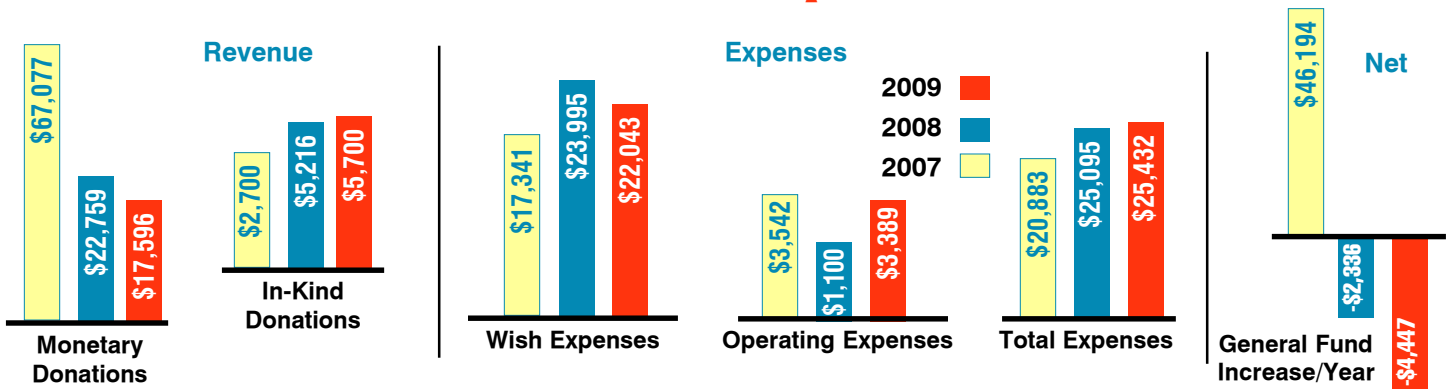

Financial Reports



Like most nonprofit organizations, The Angel Foundation is feeling the effects of poor economic conditions. Monetary donations were down 23% from 2008. (A portion of a large estate was received in 2007). Wish expenses decreased by 8% with nine fewer completed wishes. However, the average cost per wish was up 38%. In-kind donations increased by 9%. Operating expenses were nearly tripled due to some nonrefundable costs for wishes that were put together only to have the recipient expire and the development of our website. Overall, our general fund experienced a \$4,447 loss for the year, following a \$2,336 loss in 2008. The board decided to suspend Disney wishes (our most expensive wish), and limit the number of wishes for certain portions of the state.
